Why is This Important To A Customer?

Uni-ram solvent recyclers provide clean recycled solvent for reuse. The area around a solvent recycler is a "Classified Area" due to the presence of solvent, a flammable liquid. **ONLY** a **certified** solvent recycler can be placed in a Classified Area. See your National Electrical Code (NEC).

The NEC of the USA states that the area (35 feet radius) around the solvent recycler is a Classified Area. See the exhibit on page 2. The NEC also states that the work shop and paint room in all collision repair shops are Classified Areas. **ONLY** a certified solvent recycler can be placed in a Classified Area. Compliance is important to employees, owners, Government Agencies and insurance companies.

The classified area is a radius of 12 meters from the solvent recycler, the source of solvent, the flammable liquid. Source: NEC for USA.

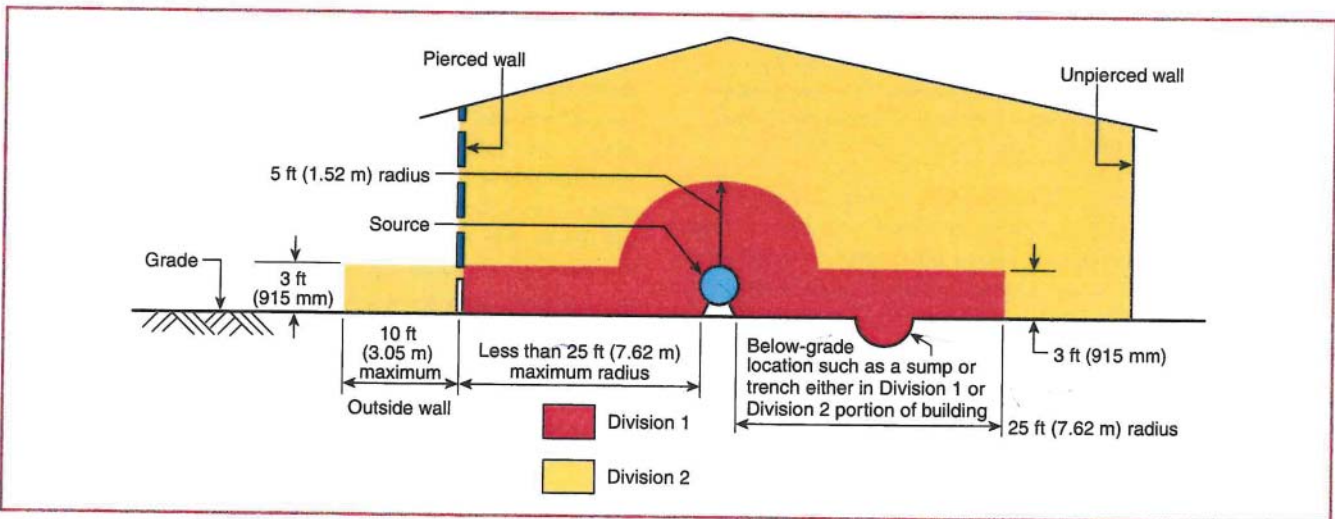


EXHIBIT 500.1 An example of an area classification drawing.
