REPLACING AN OLD TIMER SWITCH 115-200K (WHITE HOUSING) WITH A NEW TIMER SWITCH 115-2050 (BLACK HOUSING)




A. Remove old timer

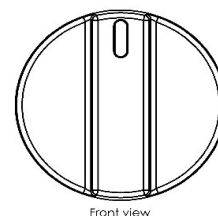
1. Disconnect the air supply to the unit.
2. Remove timer knob by sliding it outwards using a screwdriver as a wedge if necessary.
3. Remove mounting screws and move the timer out of the way but do not disconnect it.

B. Install new timer

1. Follow the instructions below for the specific model and type of timer you are replacing, keeping in mind that some models have more than one type of timer.

2. There are three configurations of the knob to fit different applications.

3. Find the suitable knob configuration from the following table; prepare the knob accordingly.

4. for UG110, UG2000 and UG3000 ONLY, install the provided undercut screw and nut into the existing hole, screw head shall be inside the cabinet.

5. Disconnect one tube on the old timer by pulling back on the blue collar and pulling out the tube. Connect this tube to the same port on the new timer, then do the same for the second tube.

6. Insert the shaft of Timer from inside, line up the holes in the timer housing with the mounting holes, secure the timer with provided new screws.

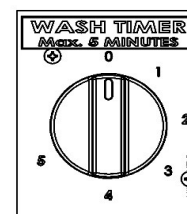
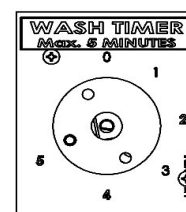
7. Push the prepared knob onto the shaft, Knob's indicator could be pointing upward or to the left, it depends on machine's model number.

C. Test new timer

1. Close lid of cleaning tank.

2. Connect air supply to the unit.

3. Turn timer knob clockwise to ensure the timer is working properly. This can be identified by pump being actuated for about 45 to 60 seconds.



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
